ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Expo II Bike Path Northvale Segment project proposes to construct a new bikeway north of I-10 between Motor Ave. and Overland Ave. This project will close the existing gap in the Expo Bike Path, completing a continuous bike facility that generally runs parallel to the Expo Line from Culver City to Santa Monica.

PAST ENGAGEMENT

In January 2016, the project team engaged community members through an open house, where input was gathered on design options, access points, and interim connecting measures. Participants shared their thoughts and concerns about the project, and indicated their preferred option for the bikeway design between Dunleer Dr. and Putney Dr. A summary of this meeting is available on the #LeapLA Blog at bike.lacity.org.

CURRENT STATUS

Since 2016, an interim bike route was installed along Northvale Rd. from Motor Ave. to Overland Ave. using signage and sharrow markings to provide continuous access across the gap for cyclists using the Expo Bike Path.

At the same time the City has been developing the design of the bikeway in accordance with the input received at the first community meeting. A second meeting is being held in June 2018 to share updates on the bikeway alignment and design and to solicit feedback on specific elements.

Current features of the project include:



A two-way **Bike Path** (off-street) from Motor Ave. to Dunleer Dr. within existing public right-of-way and easements, fully separated from the street.



Two-way **Bike Path** (off-street) or protected **Bike Lanes** (on-street) along the south side of Northvale Rd. between Dunleer Dr. and Putney Rd. providing a safe, comfortable bicycling experience alongside the street.



New **Traffic Signal** at Motor Ave. and bike path entrance to allow for a safe connection for pedestrians and bicyclists from Motor Ave.



New **Bikeway Lighting** to ensure a safe walking and bicycling experience after dark.
